- 1. What are the different roles and tasks of the three UN organizations World Food Programme (WFP), Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD)? How do they contribute to implementing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)? What is there input to achieve food security?
- 2. The European Union (EU) is strongly protecting its own farmers but pushing other countries to introduce free agricultural trade. Having in mind that 80% of the world food is produced on small farms under insecure tenure conditions, do you think the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) is favourable to support fair and ecological farming by smallholders?
