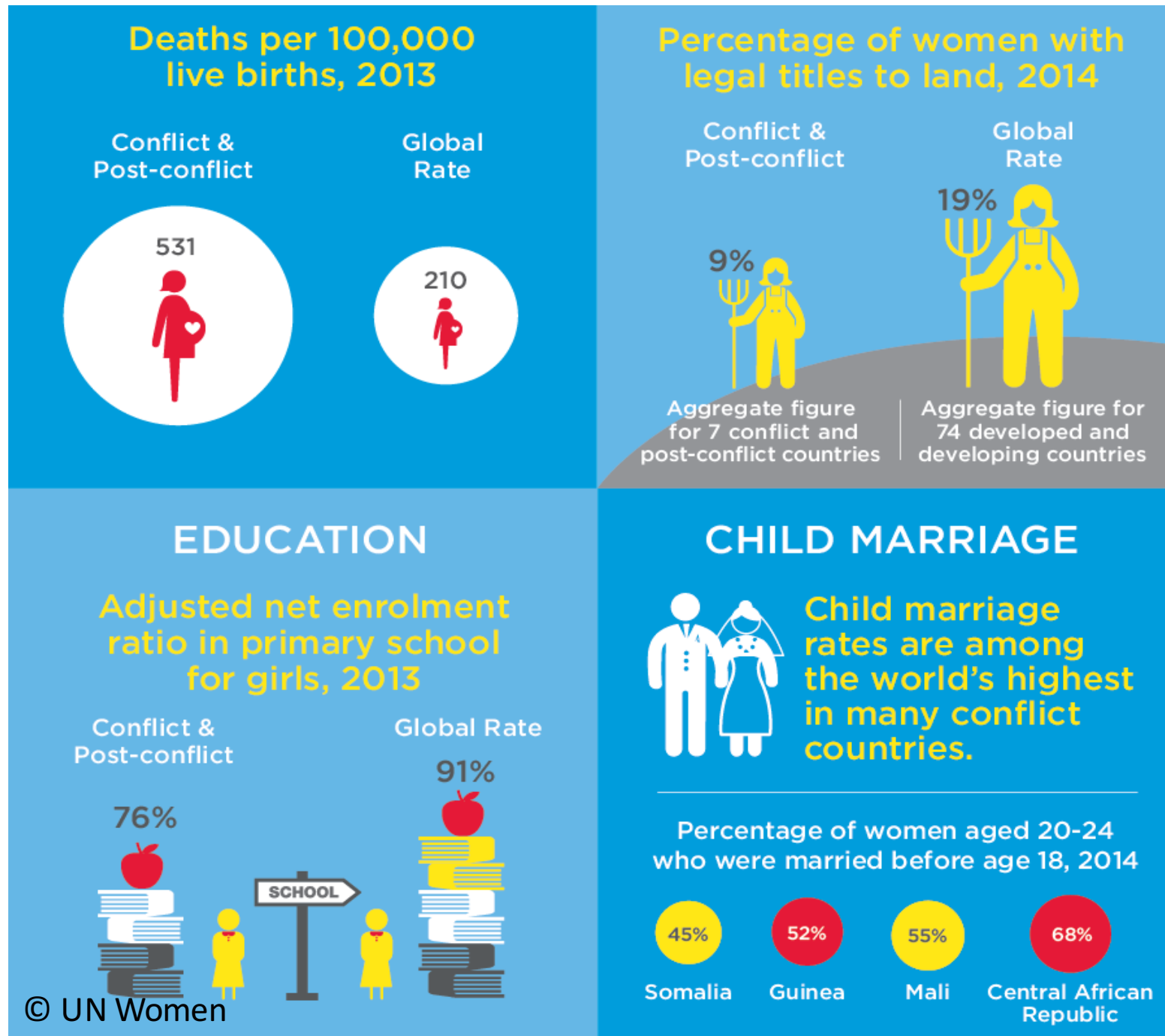
Armed conflict and crisis

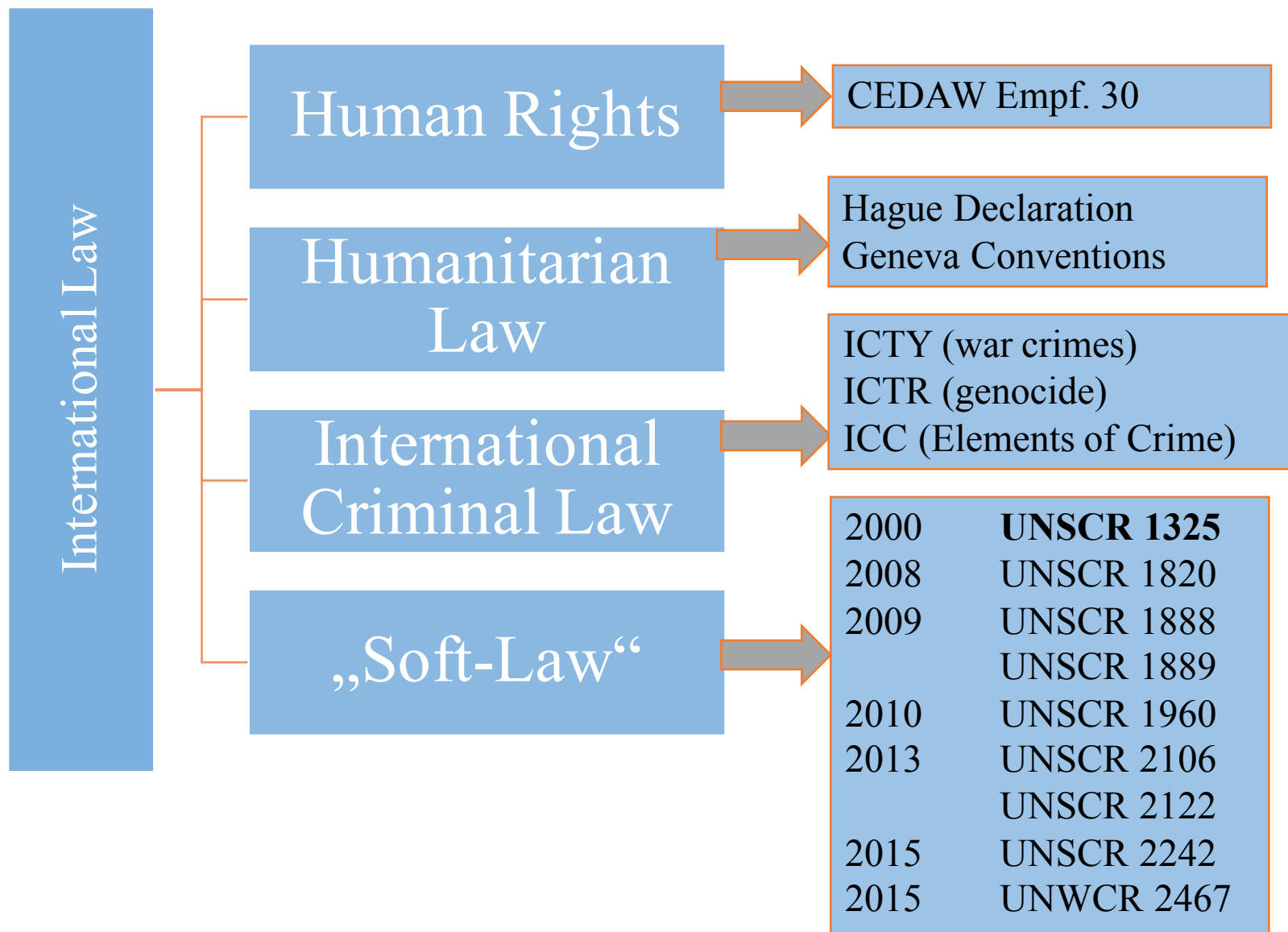
